



Instructions for Authors

Descriptional Complexity of Formal Systems
High Tatras, Slovakia, July 20–22, 2007

The length of a submission should not exceed 12 pages, fitting to a4 paper, using 11pt character size, and standard line spacing. If you believe that more details are necessary to substantiate the main claims of your contribution, but these details would not fit within the given page limit, you may include a clearly marked appendix that will be read at the discretion of Program Committee.

Submitted versions of contributions should not reveal identity of authors. Such confidential information will be handled by Program Committee Chairs only, but not forwarded to other PC members or referees.

Simultaneous submissions to other conferences with published proceedings are not allowed.

(We remind that the Program Committee can decide to accept a paper as a regular contribution, in full length of 12 pages, or as a short contribution, the final version of which should not exceed 8 pages in the proceedings.)

Technical details for preparing a manuscript

The DCFS 2007 proceedings now comes with its own layout design, which has been implemented as a new document class; ‘dcfs07’ for L^AT_EX 2_ε.

If you do not want to bother with learning how to code the preamble of your submitted paper with commands of a new document class, just use the standard ‘article’ class, with the following character size and printing area setup at the top of your L^AT_EX input:

\documentclass[11pt]{article}
\setlength{\textheight}{21.25cm}
\setlength{\textwidth}{13.5cm}
\setlength{\topmargin}{0.4cm}
\setlength{\oddsidemargin}{1.3cm}
\setlength{\evensidemargin}{1.3cm}
```

However, if you would like to see your paper formatted in the same way as it will be in the printed DCFS 2007 proceedings, e.g., all page and line breaks in the same places where they will actually appear, use `\documentclass{dcfs07}` instead of ‘article’. Sending your submission

Before doing this, you will need the following two files:

(1) Either a *.pdf or a *.ps output containing your paper (together with an optional appendix for the Program Committee), but *not containing* any confidential information revealing your identity. (If you decided to prepare your paper

with the `dcfs07` document class, just compile with the `[sub]` class option on, this will hide the confidential information automatically.)

(2) A plain ASCII text file containing (A) confidential information, that is, name(s) of author(s), their address(es) and email(s), with clearly marked corresponding author, (B) title, abstract, and keywords. (A copy pasted from your `*.tex` input file will do.)

When you have prepared the above two files, send them, as attachments, to the email address
